

# Pumpkin Project



The pumpkin project varies slightly for grades 1-2, 3, 4, and 5.

**1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> grades:** Select your favorite book and create your pumpkin to look like a character in it. Complete the book report paper to go with it.

**3<sup>rd</sup> grade:** Your pumpkin will be decorated as a character from one of the fairy tales we studied. You will write or type a colorful description of your character to go along with it. Use the *Character to a T* form for the character study.

**4<sup>th</sup> grade:** Your pumpkin will be decorated as your missing person. Include a 5\*7 index card with your case number and missing person's name on it.

**5<sup>th</sup> grade:** Your pumpkin will be decorated as the person you chose for your biography. You will include the biography sheet that was handed to you in class.

## Pumpkin Rules

Pumpkins may be no bigger than your head. Please do not get a 'porch pumpkin,' which is a pumpkin you may need help carrying. If you cannot carry it yourself, it is too big. The pumpkin should be about the size of one you get on a hayride.
